Side Tilt Carriages

Side Tilt Carriage - There are actually 4 sizings of hook type blade carriages rated by the tine carriage lifting capability. Hook type tine carriages have been consistent.

Class I carriages are rated for loads as much as 2000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing utilized for Class I is thirteen inches. Class II carriages are rated for loads as much as 5,550 lbs. Their carriage bar spacing is sixteen inches. Class III carriages are rated for cargo up to 10,000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this particular class is twenty inches. Class IV carriages are rated for loads as much as 15,500 lbs. The carriage bar spacing used for this capacity is twenty five inches.

Pin mounted blades vary by the amount of offset between the fork and the blade eye. Various manufacturers would vary the carriages for pin type blades. Carriage capacity will be determined by the carriage pin size and by the blade size.
