As opposed to the quick-tach container models, universal fit buckets are 50% deeper. This extra space makes them perfect for lifting irregular shaped loads like elevating roof gravel, moving large debris piles, broken up concrete, backfilling behind walls and tearing off roof trash.

The Quick-Tach can dump things approximately 1.5 feet higher because of the shorter depth of its bucket.
